



Flags - Instructions

Materials List

1. Ground Steak
2. Bolt
3. Metal Cross Bars
4. Stakes
5. Flag Pole
6. Flag Rod
7. Nylon Carrying case
8. Flag
9. PVC Water Weight (optional)

Assembly Instructions for Indoor Use

Step 1: Fasten the bolt to the bottom of the of the metal cross bar, ensuring the crossbars form an "X" (All crossbar 'feet' should touch the ground, if not switch the crossbars)

Step 2: Fasten the flag holder base to the top of the crossbar.

Step 3: Attach the flagpole to the flag holder base.

Step 4: Feed the flag rod through the sleeve of the flag, making sure it goes all the way to the top to guarantee stability.

Step 5: Take the flag with inserted rod and fasten it onto the flag holder base.

Step 6: Tie the elastic cord, pulling it tight to keep the flag smooth, and wrap it around the knob on the side of the flag pole to make it secure.

Assembly Instructions for Outdoor Use

Step 1: Fasten the bolt to the bottom of the of the metal cross bar, ensuring the crossbars form an "X" (All crossbar 'feet' should touch the ground, if not switch the crossbars)

Step 2: Fasten the ground steak to the bolt underneath the metal crossbars

Step 3: Fasten the flag holder base to the top of the crossbar.

Step 4: Attach the flagpole to the flag holder base.

Step 5: Feed the flag rod through the sleeve of the flag, making sure it goes all the way to the top to guarantee stability.

Step 6: Take the flag with inserted rod and fasten it onto the flag holder base.

Step 7: Tie the elastic cord, pulling it tight to keep the flag smooth, and wrap it around the knob on the side of the flag pole to make it secure.

Step 8: If using PVC water weight or other weight, add it ovetop of the flag holder base to secure the flag.
